


2015-2016 Online Success Rates, California Community Colleges







What barriers exist within our classes and institutional processes that disproportionately impact students?



67% of California **Community College** students identify as an ethnic minority.




4 in 10 **California Community College students are** first generation students.


Social Presence

"the degree to which participants are able to project themselves affectively within the medium" (Garrison, 1997, p. 6)

"feeling that others are involved in the communication process" (Whiteman, 2002, p. 6)

- "degree to which a person is perceived as a 'real' person in mediated communication" (Gunawardena & Zittle, 1997)
- "the degree of person to person awareness" (Tu, 2000, p. 1662)
- sense of belonging to a community (Picciano, 2002)
